White House Counsel Bob Bauer to Speak on Judicial Nominations

Washington, D.C. – White House Counsel Robert F. Bauer will provide a keynote speech on the administration’s efforts to fill vacancies on the federal bench at an event hosted by the American Constitution Society for Law and Policy (ACS). Following Bauer’s speech, “Judicial Nominations in 2011,” a panel of experts will examine the number of vacancies on the federal bench and the pace of confirmation of judicial nominations. The event is part of ACS’s ongoing work to educate the public and media about the crisis the federal bench faces because of rising court vacancies and obstacles in the Senate to confirmation of judicial selections.
