Hon. Mary Ann McMorrow

Former Illinois Supreme Court justice; elected to Circuit Court in 1976; appointed to Appellate Court in 1985 and elected in 1986; elected to the Illinois Supreme Court in 1992, becoming the first woman to serve on the Court; elected Chief Justice in 2002, becoming the first woman to head any of the three branches of Illinois government; retired in July 2006.



Ronald S. Miller

Partner, Miller, Shakman & Beem LLP; past Co-Chair of Chicago Lawyers' Committee for Civil Rights Under Law; past President of University of Illinois Law School Board of Visitors; Co-Chair of the Advisory Board of the Illinois ACLU; inducted as Laureate in the Illinois Academy of Lawyers.



James D. Montgomery

Managing Partner, Cochran & Montgomery; litigation practice focused on plaintiff's personal injury, medical malpractice, products' liability, and civil rights; first African-American Corporation Counsel for the City of Chicago, 1983-1986; inducted in the National Bar Association Hall of Fame and as Laureate in the Illinois Academy of Lawyers.



Hon. Milton I. Shadur

Senior Judge, Northern District of Illinois; appointed to the Northern District in 1980; former litigation practice at Goldberg, Devoe, Shadur & Mikva (in various forms between 1949-1980); fellow, American Bar Foundation; awarded University of Chicago Professional Achievement Citation.
