Work will primarily consist of research and writing on issues related to end of life healthcare and are likely to involve civil, criminal and constitutional law. Other duties may be assigned as needed.

Clerks should have:

- 1. Interest in advocacy related to end of life healthcare issues including, but not limited to, medical aid in dying, medical malpractice, advanced directives, free speech and religious exemptions.
- 2. Excellent oral and written communication skills.
- 3. The ability to work independently and cooperatively with different types of

people.

4. Possess advanced computer and legal research skills, including Westlaw.

Compassion & Choices will pay each legal fellow \$1000/week in compensation, but is unable to offer benefits.
