RE: Guidelines and Release for Speakers

Thank you for agreeing to speak at an event organized by the American Constitution Society. We look forward to introducing you to our network of attorneys, law students and scholars.

As you know, ACS is a 501(c)(3) educational organization whose mission is to promote the vitality of the United States Constitution and the fundamental values it expresses: individual rights and liberties, genuine equality, access to justice, democracy and the rule of law. Among other things, ACS provides a forum for debate about existing policies and new proposals on important issues. As part of our educational activities, we often post video, still photography and transcripts of programs on our website. We have found that doing so greatly increases the number of people who will be exposed to the ideas discussed at our programs.

As a tax-exempt educational organization, ACS is prohibited from using its funds to finance partisan activity or intervention in an election. While we are free to promote or criticize <u>ideas</u> or <u>policies</u>, we cannot support any statements or activities that constitute endorsements of <u>candidates</u> or <u>political parties</u>. These restrictions apply to all events or publications hosted or sponsored by ACS. Thus, we ask that you please refrain from expressing any views that could be reasonably interpreted as endorsing any candidate or party in an election. If you are a candidate seeking office, please do not solicit donations or support for your candidacy in conjunction with this event. This guidance should in no way restrict your selection of issues to discuss or the style and manner in which you share your opinions.

Your signature below indicates that, of your own free will and intending to be legally bound, you:

- (1) acknowledge receipt of and agree to comply with the above guidance;
- (2) agree that nothing in your presentation will constitute defamation, invasion of privacy or publicity, infringe the rights of any third party (including, without limitation, copyright, trademark and patent rights) or violate any other law;
- (3) agree that ACS may record your presentation and that you hereby grant ACS, its agents, employees, licensees and assigns the right to use the audio and/or video footage or still photography of you and a transcript of your remarks, in whole or in part, for any purposes in any media now known or hereinafter invented, including but not limited to, simultaneous and archival webcasting; and
- (4) acknowledge that you will receive no monetary payments or other compensation for your appearance or participation.
