



STEP #1: Edit Font

Left click on top of text and edit as you would any word document. When you have finished one field, left click on the next. Professional bios can serve as a good reference.



STEP #2: Edit Pics

Download high resolution, brightly colored image from internet image search and save to computer desktop.

Right click template image, select “change picture.” Maneuver to the file you wish to use and select it. Resize and relocate image as necessary.

STEP #3: Save and Print

From file menu, select “Save As.” Save file as .PDF extension. Email file to printing service or print from your personal account/printer.

This template is optimized for 8.5” x 11” tabletop flyers and 13” x 19” foam board mounted posters, but it will work on most paper sizes.
